*Give eye contact but don't demand it from the students. When appropriate, try Three-Point Communication.*

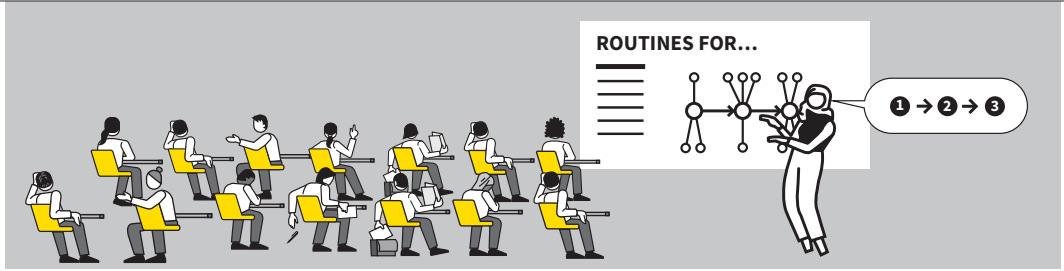
*Assertiveness should be talked about a lot more – and in a way that turns the nebulous concept into practical strategies.*

*Make your voice fill the space in a calm way – definitely not shouting.*

*Communicate 'I mean it' in your speaking.*

*Have a constant monitoring of behaviour going on in your head.*

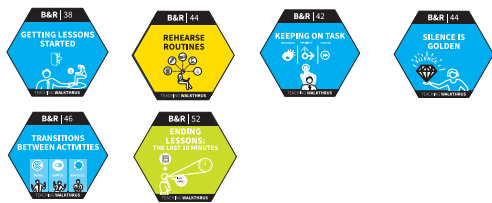
*Rewards and sanctions do work for the majority of students. Use them to avoid issues.*

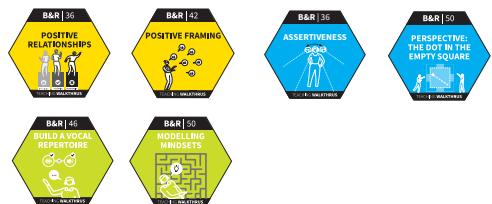

**ESTABLISH YOUR EXPECTATIONS**

This is a key technique. Students can't be clear on classroom protocols if you, the teacher, don't know and haven't communicated in detail what is required.

**FRONT LOADING BEHAVIOUR MANAG.**

Contains several highly practical ways to ensure students know exactly what is expected of them and how to monitor.

**POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS**

Establishing expectations allows for the building of positive relationships – the heart of a safe learning environment where students know they are cared for by the adult in the room. Knowing students' names – and using them – from the very start is an essential to indicate your care.

**POSITIVE FRAMING**

Another aspect of relationship building, this entails saying what you want, not what you don't.

**ASSERTIVENESS | BUILD A VOCAL REPERTOIRE**
