Give eye contact but don't demand it from the students. When appropriate, try Three-Point Communication.


Assertiveness should be talked about a lot more and in a way that turns the nebulous concept into practical strategies.

Make your voice fill the space in a calm way - definitely not shouting.

Communicate 'I mean it' in your speaking.

Have a constant monitoring of behaviour going on in your head.

Rewards and sanctions do work for the majority of students. Use them to avoid issues.

POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS

Establishing expectations allows for the building of positive relationships — the heart of a safe learning environment where students know they are cared for by the adult in the room. Knowing students' names — and using them from the very start is an essential to indicate your care.

POSITIVE FRAMING

Another aspect of relationship building, this entails saying what you want, not what you don't.
